§ 0 Shine on

- 1st The AK is called "MAG-Life AK", where AK stands for "Absurd Cult" and stands for "working group". The appropriate variant can be selected as desired.
- 2nd The AK is a working group of the Scout troop "DPSG DonBosco Dahl/Rummenohl"
- 3. The AK is politically and religiously neutral.

§ 1 Overarching objective

§ 2 Realization of Purpose

- 4th The AK finances itself independently and organizes external funds as needed, but still keeps open the possibility of using funds offered to it.

§ 3 Members

- 1st Members can become rovers and (active/passive) leaders who are aware that the MAG-Life AK stands for more than just a flashlight.
- 2nd The inner conviction of the MagLite flashlight is enough, it does not require its own MagLite, but is of course desirable.
- 3. Children and wards of members are also members, because good education begins early.
- 4th Every member can accept new members into the AK all year round, preferably during the dark.
- 5th Every member can participate in AK meetings, but attendance is not mandatory.
- 6th "Shine On!" is the greeting of the AK members.

§ Pi Organs of the AK

- 1st Batteries (AAA to D), because without juice there is no light.
- 2nd Xenon, LED and incandescent bulbs, the right light source for every mood.
- 3. MagLite of different models (diverse), because variety lights the way.

§ 4 Meetings

- 1st The working group meets when it deems it necessary or when someone has lost their flashlight.
- 2nd Meetings can be called by all members for any purpose in accordance with the statutes, especially in the event of sudden darkness.
- 3. A protocol is not mandatory, because who needs documentation when the light is shining?

§ 5 Dissolution and withdrawal

- 1st A leak is equivalent to the extinguishing of the MagLite, which is usually remedied by changing the battery is prevented.

The MAG-Life Working Group (AK) is an integral part of the Scout troop "Don Bosco Dahl/Rummenohl" and acts in accordance with the DPSG regulations and the established thematic focus of the AK. As an independent and advisory body, the AK can expand its activities not only at tribal level, but also at district, regional, and become involved at the diocesan or federal level.

Overarching goals and their realization

The basic framework of the work of the AK is to promote voluntary work. This should be achieved through active example and varied actionism both locally and regionally. At the same time, the work of the AK aims to strengthen children and young people in their personal development, taking into account societal and institutional requirements and expectations consciously and creatively.

Promoting and maintaining the MagLite tradition: The AK strives to preserve old traditions of scouting in conjunction with the MagLight flashlight. This is to be done through systematic archiving, processing and publication of these traditions.

In addition, the working group is actively committed to developing new ideas together with children, young people and leaders. To develop and maintain traditions. This includes in particular the promotion and awarding of MagLite legends, the use and transport of MagLight flashlights on hikes, trips and excursions as well as support for the tribe's internal fan club "1. FC MAGLite".

Enlightenment: The AK is actively committed to ensuring that MagLight flashlights are used in joint actions and trips are always present. The AK traditionally appeals to its members and finds creative ways to successfully achieve this goal.
